Be the Body of Christ

Pray for repentance and transformation within the Church (your church and all the churches in Sydney):

- Acknowledge the authority of Christ as the head of the Church and that he has appointed leaders to guide us - pray for them to lead in humility
- Acknowledge the 'Law of the Spirit of Life'; the new wine being poured into the hearts of those willing to receive - pray that the gifts will be used to glorify God and serve the Church
- Acknowledge that we (the Church) have allowed spiritual pride and superiority to divide us and destroy the reputation of Christians as a whole: repent on behalf of the Church (stand in the gap) and pray that all Christians repent and seek God's forgiveness and restoration so we can become one Church, one body, one Bride of Christ
- Acknowledge that Sydney belongs to God and that the blood of Christ and grace of God is what keeps the city from catastrophe: pray for restoration of the fear of God (the beginning of wisdom) and opportunities for the Church to speak out with favour about God and Christ Jesus
- Acknowledge that the battle will not be won merely with the procedure of "binding" and "loosing". It will be won with Christlike character and holding fast to the word of God has spoken.
- Acknowledge that to facilitate boldness in our faith and have effective witness, our confession must be without exaggeration or presumptuous statements, and there is no place for false humility.
- Acknowledge that God is indeed preparing an exceedingly great army. Through it He intends to pull down the strongholds in the cities. However, they must be connected in Christ before the Spirit will anoint them for effective spiritual warfare.
- Acknowledge one person's transformation from carnality to the image of Christ will revolutionise a church, the transformation of the citywide church into the image of Christ will revolutionise a city.

Let us ask ourselves today: Are we doing what Jesus did? For whatever Jesus did, the Spirit-anointed church will do likewise.

Our prayer is that you will hear God's heart for yourself and, joined with others of like vision, will help build the house of the Lord wherever you are.
